Dear Chair Murray, Chair Granger, Vice Chair Collins, Ranking Member DeLauro, Chair Shaheen, Chair Rogers, Ranking Member Moran, and Ranking Member Cartwright:

We urge you to include language in the final FY2024 Commerce, Justice, & Science appropriations bill that ensures the Commerce Department can fund the position of the <u>Assistant Secretary for</u> <u>Travel and Tourism</u>. Specifically, please include (1) bill text that explicitly allows the International Trade Administration (ITA) to use its funds to implement sections 604 and 605 of the Visit America Act (as enacted in the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023), as well as (2) language in the accompanying Joint Explanatory Statement that strongly encourages ITA to establish the office of the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Travel and Tourism.

As you know, travel is a major contributor to the nation's economy, generating \$2.6 trillion in economic activity annually, which supports 15 million American jobs. However, even though every other industry depends on travel to drive growth, innovation, education, and operations—from

agriculture and healthcare to defense and energy—the travel experience is often encumbered by archaic, confusing, and disjointed government policies and processes.

A recent analysis of key travel metrics across the globe—such as connectivity, leadership, security and facilitation—found that the United States ranks 17th out of the top 18 travel markets in terms of global competitiveness. Key among the findings is that the U.S. ranks last when it comes to government leadership on travel-related issues and the strength of its national travel strategy.¹

Since travel touches so many areas of the government—from TSA, CBP, and FAA to the Department of Commerce, the Department of State and more—a senior federal official is needed to streamline government processes and services that affect travel. Without such, the U.S. will continue to lag behind its rivals and struggle to consistently implement a national travel and tourism strategy governmentwide, to the benefit of all types of travelers.

The Visit America Act, which received broad bipartisan support in both the House and Senate,² created the office of the Assistant Secretary for Travel and Tourism to:

- Develop and implement a national strategy to grow domestic and international inbound travel,
- Help streamline government processes affecting both business and leisure travel, and
- Help U.S. cities and counties in their bids for large international meetings and events.

With the rest of the world becoming more open to large-scale meetings and events, and the U.S. remaining the only G2O country without a federal agency or cabinet-level official in charge of travel policy, more needs to be done to ensure America remains a competitive place to host international events and attract new investors and visitors.

That's why we urge you to support language in FY24 appropriations that ensures the International Trade Administration can fund the position of the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Travel and Tourism as soon as possible. Thank you for your time and attention on this issue.
